## ADOPT-A-FAMILY DONOR INSTRUCTIONS

Once you have received information on your adopted family, you will want to shop for appropriate items: two new toys for each child and one item for the adult(s) in the family.

Place all items in sturdy boxes, remembering to pack lightly for easy handling. Deliver all gifts together to the Southern Contracting Company office located at 559 North Twin Oaks Valley Road in San Marcos. At time of drop-off, please identify your family's name to the Southern Contracting associate who accepts your donation. This will assist us in making sure each family receives the gift intended for them.

Here is a list of suggested items:

Size/age appropriate clothes, such as pants, shirts, shoes, socks, underwear, jackets, etc.

Age appropriate toys, two per child.

A pre-cooked Holiday family meal from a local store such as the ones offered on the attached flyer by Albertsons or a gift card to a local store for groceries.

Miscellaneous other items such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, hair brushes, or stocking stuffers like candy canes, hair-ties, hot wheels, deck of cards, etc.
